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# ACTIVITY OPTIONS

## ACTIVITY 1: THE KING'S THRONE

**WHAT YOU'LL NEED: PILLOW, BLANKET, STREAMERS, TAPE**

Use an adult-sized chair for this activity. Set out a pillow, a blanket, streamers (or toilet paper), and tape. Help your children decorate the chair to make it a comfortable royal throne. Tell them that thrones are so special that only kings or queens can sit on them. When the throne is decorated, allow your children to take turns sitting on it. Tell them that in this week's story, Esther went to see the king in his throne room.

## ACTIVITY 2: FIX A FEAST

**WHAT YOU'LL NEED: SANDWICH SUPPLIES**

Set out sandwich supplies such as bread, bologna, cheese, mayonnaise, and the works. Have your children work individually to build special sandwiches. Arrange their sandwiches on a silver tray or serving platter. As children are working, explain that in this week's story, Esther prepared a special meal for the king. Then have a "banquet" with your kids. Prepare the table and gather to prayer before eating your deliciously prepared sandwiches.

## ACTIVITY 3: PLANTING THE SEED

**WHAT YOU'LL NEED: PHONE OR COMPUTER**

# CRAFT IDEAS

## CRAFT 1: WE CAN DO GREAT THINGS

**WHAT YOU'LL NEED: BLANK PAPER, MARKERS, CRAYONS, STICKERS, JEWELS, ETC**

Roll up a blank piece of paper in a "hot dog roll" (or length-wise). Allow your children to decorate the roll however they see fit. Pretend the paper is a scepter and remind them that **God made us special, and we can do great things.**
